New book celebrates the 100-year history of Shades Cahaba School

HOMEWOOD, AL (September 2020) — Local author and graphic designer Shawn Wright, has released the book Shades Cahaba: The First 100 Years to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Shades Cahaba Elementary School in

Homewood, Alabama.

Originally opened as a high school in rural southern Jefferson County, Alabama, Shades Cahaba grew as the community grew around it. In 1949 the high school students left for the newly built Shades Valley High School, and

Shades Cahaba continued to educate elementary students.

"My brother and I both attended Shades Cahaba Elementary School, and I had many questions about its history even back then. Once my children started to attend, those questions came up again, and this time I decided to find out the answers," said Wright. "The centennial was fast approaching, so I created the Shades Cahaba Oral History Project to

reach out to alumni, teachers, and others and to learn the history of Shades Cahaba."

The book grew out of the 23 podcast episodes and blog posts that are a part of the Shades Cahaba Oral History

Project.

"My podcast guests helped me uncover the rich history of the school. We covered subjects such as how the school was started, who the principals were, the coaches, athletics, and student and faculty stories. We even talked about the beginnings of Shades Valley High School and Homewood High School and how the school successfully integrated

in the 1960s. All of this and more is covered in the book," said Wright.

The book is available on Amazon.com as paperback and Kindle versions. It is also available digitally on Apple books.

"We hope to have copies available for purchase in Homewood stores soon," said Wright.
